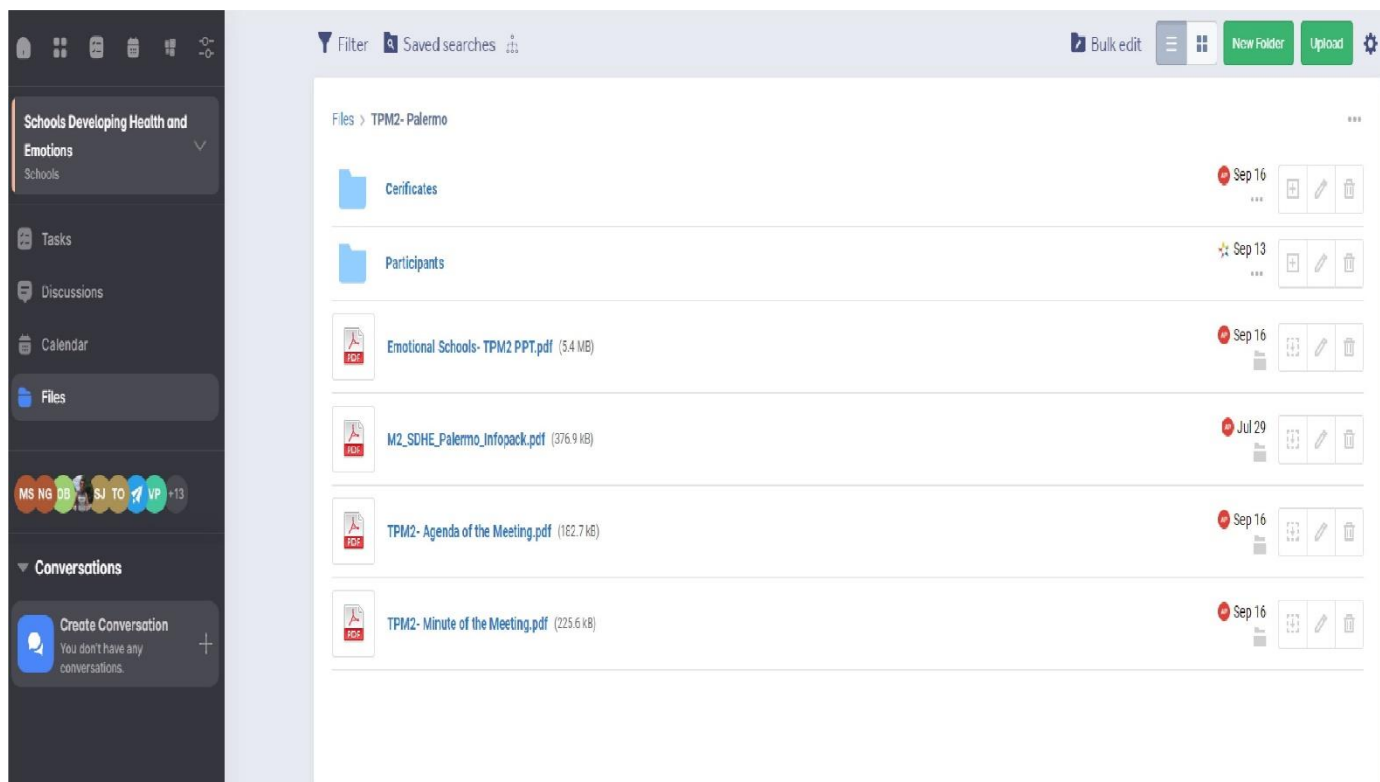

PURPOSE
To improve the quality, training and efficiency of the work of professionals in the field of school education who are responsible for promoting comprehensive health and emotional education in secondary schools.

ACTIVITIES
The Project is made of local and international activities: coordination meetings among Project organisations, analysis of the situation in each country, identification of good practices, meetings in each country, analysis of learning needs, two Study Visits, one in Spain and one in Poland, creation of the Methodological Guide "Educating in Sustainable Integral Health", Multiplier Events to present the project results, Final Evaluation Meeting and final versions of the eBook and video.

METHODOLOGY
The methodology of the project is based on the principles of non-formal education and experiential learning. It is participatory and active and the contact is worked in a dynamic and enjoyable way, which leads participants to experiment and put the content and tools into practice in an environment of trust, tolerance, empathy and respect.

6 different entities: Ica NBB, a university, two secondary schools, a VET school and a public institution responsible for educational initiatives from five European countries: Ireland, Italy, Portugal, Romania and Spain.
